### CHEFS' PRESENTATIONS AT THE VILLAGE GREEN

Local and celebrated chefs and producers combine to offer a programme of cooking demonstrations throughout the day from 11am to 4pm.

#### 11am

Local resident Julie Mews and Lisa Hummel-Robson, authors of *The Food Lovers' Guide to Perth* will prepare a risotto with local asparagus while providing tips on fresh, local and seasonal foods.

#### 12 noon

Bindoon Bakehaus's pastry chefs will show you how they prepare the renowned orange and almond cake and share recipes for baking the best bread.

#### 2pm

Pâtissier and author, Emmanuel Mollois from Choux Café, will share his techniques for making a traditional Tarte au Citron using Chittering Valley lemons and other French pastry secrets.

#### 3pm

The Cooking Professor, Peter Kenyon will draw on quality local ingredients to create Slow Braised Chittering Beef in Red Wine and a Moondah Chicken Tagine with Preserved Chittering Lemon.
